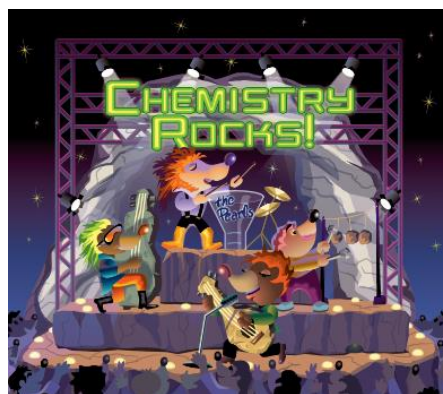
Directions: Turn on Mt Pelia Road from University St (Hwy 431). The University Center is on the left between the library and student housing.
